**The Stamps (Antigua and Barbuda) (Anniversaries and Events) Order 2002, made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act, Cap. 410.**

| 1. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Anniversaries and Events) Order 2002.  | Short Title.   |
| 2. Special stamps of the value of \$2.00 and \$2.50 each on three (3) Sheetlets, and two (2) Souvenir Sheets at \$6.00 each are authorized for sale in Antigua and Barbuda. | Special Stamp. |
| 3. The design of the stamps authorized by this Order are specified in the Schedule.   | Design.        |
| 4. The special stamps authorized by this Order shall remain on sale until 14th October 2002, or until stocks are exhausted, whichever is earlier.                           | Duration.      |
