The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Anniversaries and Events) Order, 2004 made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act, Cap. 410.

1. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Anniversaries and Events) Order, 2004.

Short title.

2. Special stamps of the value and description specified in the Schedule are authorised for sale in Antigua and Barbuda.

Special stamps, Schedule,

3. The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale for a period of three (3) months until 16th September, 2004 or until stocks are exhausted whichever date is sooner.

4. This Order comes into force on 17th June, 2004.
