Duration.

The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Anniversaries and Events) Order, 2005 made by the Cabinet under Sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act, Cap 410.

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Anniversaries and Events) Order, 2005.
- 2. Special stamps of the value and description specified in Special Stamps. the Schedule are authorized for sale in Antigua and Barbuda.
- 3. The special stamps authorized by this Order shall remain on sale for a period of three (3) months until 14th September, 2005 or until stocks are exhausted, whichever is earlier.
  - 4. This Order comes into force on 15th June, 2005.
