The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Fauna and Flora) Order, 1995 made by the Cabinet under Sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act (Cap. 270).

- 1. Short title. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Fauna and Flora) Order, 1995.
- 2. Special Stamp. Special Stamps of the value of 45¢, 75¢, 90¢, \$1.20, \$1.65, \$1.75 and three Souvenir sheets of the value of \$6.00 each are authorized for sale in Antigua and Barbuda.
- 3. Design. The design of the stamps authorized by this Order is specified in the Schedule.
- 4. Duration. The special stamps authorized by this Order shall remain on sale until 29th November, 1995 or until stocks are exhausted, whichever is earlier.
 - 5. Commencement. This Order comes into force on 7th day of September, 1995.
