

ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA

STATUTORY INSTRUMENT

1995, No. 28

The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Fauna and Flora) Order, 1995 made by the Cabinet under Sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act (Cap. 270).

1. Short title. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Fauna and Flora) Order, 1995.

2. Special Stamp. Special Stamps of the value of 45¢, 75¢, 90¢, \$1.20, \$1.65, \$1.75 and three Souvenir sheets of the value of \$6.00 each are authorized for sale in Antigua and Barbuda.

3. Design. The design of the stamps authorized by this Order is specified in the Schedule.

4. Duration. The special stamps authorized by this Order shall remain on sale until 29th November, 1995 or until stocks are exhausted, whichever is earlier.

5. Commencement. This Order comes into force on 7th day of September, 1995.

SCHEDULE

The stamps are multicoloured, of horizontal and vertical format and feature the following —

45¢	features	— Twelve (12) different breeds of cats, namely — Samali, Persian, Devon Rex, Turkish Angora, Himalayan, Maine Coon, Nonpedigree, American Wirehair, British Shorthair, American Curl, Nonpedigree, Birman.
75¢	features	— Twelve (12) different types of flowers, namely — Narcissus, Camelia, Iris, Tulip, Poppy, Peony, Magnolia, Oriental Lily, Rose, Pansie, Hydrangea, Azaleas.

90¢	depicts	— The Mining Bee.
\$1.20	depicts	— The Solitary Bee.
\$1.65	depicts	— The Leaf Cutter.
\$1.75	depicts	— The Honey Bee.
\$6.00	Souvenir Sheet I features	— The Siberian Cat and Norwegian Forest Cat.
\$6.00	Souvenir Sheet II features	— The Mining Bee, the Leaf Cutter and the Solitary Mining Bee.
\$6.00	Souvenir Sheet III depicts	— The Calla Lily, Bird of Paradise and Anthurium.
