The Stamps (Antigua and Barbuda) (Fauna and Flora of the Caribbean) Order 2002, made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act, Cap. 410.

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Short title. Barbuda) (Fauna and Flora of the Caribbean) Order 2002.
- 2. Special stamps of the value of  $50\phi$ ,  $75\phi$ , \$1.00, \$1.80, two Special Stamp. sheetlets of the value of  $90\phi$  and \$1.00, and two Souvenir Sheets of the value of \$6.00 each are authorized for sale in Antigua and Barbuda.
- **3.** The design of the stamps authorized by this Order are Design. specified in the Schedule.
- 4. The special stamps authorized by this Order shall remain Duration. on sale until 7th July, 2002 or until stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier.
- **5.** This Order is deemed to have come into force on the 8th Commencement. February, 2002.
