The Stamps (Antigua and Barbuda) (Fauna and Flora of the Caribbean) Order 2002, made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act, Cap. 410.

1. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Fauna and Flora of the Caribbean) Order 2002. Short title.
2. Special stamps of the value of 50¢, 75¢, \$1.00, \$1.80, two sheetlets of the value of 90¢ and \$1.00, and two Souvenir Sheets of the value of \$6.00 each are authorized for sale in Antigua and Barbuda. Special Stamp.
3. The design of the stamps authorized by this Order are specified in the Schedule. Design.
4. The special stamps authorized by this Order shall remain on sale until 7th July, 2002 or until stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier. Duration.
5. This Order is deemed to have come into force on the 8th February, 2002. Commencement.
