The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Endangered Animals) Order, 2001 made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act, Cap. 410.

1. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Endangered Animals) Order, 2001. Short Title.
2. Special Stamps of the value of 25 cents, 30 cents, 45 cents, 75 cents, 90 cents, \$1.00, two Sheetlets comprising of 4 and 6 stamps at \$1.80 and \$2.50 each and 2 Souvenir Sheets at \$6.00 each are authorized for sale. Special Stamps.
3. The designs of the stamps authorized by this Order are depicted as follows — Design
- The 25 cents depicts collared Peccary — *Tayassu Tajiacu*
- The 30 cents depicts Baird's Tapir — *Tapirella Bairdi*
- The 45 cents depicts Agouti — *Myoprocta Acouchy*
- The 75 cents depicts Bananaquit — *Coereba Flaveola*
- The 90 cents depicts Six Banded Armadillo — *Euphractus Sexinctus*
- The \$1.00 depicts Roseate Spoonbill — *Ajaia Ajaja*
- Sheetlet 1 depicts (1) Mouse Opossum — *Didelphis Murina*
- (2) Magnificent Black Frigatebird —
(Fregata Magnificens)
- (3) Northern Jacana — *(Jacana Spinosa)*
- (4) Painted Buntin — *(Passerina Ciris)*
- (5) Haitian Solenodon — *(Solenodon Paradoxus)*
- (6) St. Lucia Iguana — *(Cyclura MacLeayi)*

- Sheetlet 2 depicts: (1) West Indian Iguana
(Iguana Delicatissima)
- (2) Scarlet Macawara Macao
- (3) Cotton Topped Tamarin
(Saguinus Oedipus)
- (4) Kinkajou— *Potos Flavus*

Souvenir Sheet 1 depicts: King Vulture —
(Sarcoramphus Papa)

Souvenir Sheet 2 depicts: Ocelot — *(Felis Pardalis)*

- Format. 4. The stamps are multicoloured and of vertical and horizontal format.
- Duration. 5. The special stamps authorized by this Order shall remain on sale for three (3) months until 9th December, 2001 or earlier, if stock becomes exhausted before that date.
- Commencement 6. This Order comes into force on 10th September, 2001.
