## The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Philanippon Art) Order, 2001 made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act, Cap. 410.

1. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Philanippon Art) Order 2001. Short title.
2. Special Stamps of the value and description specified in the Schedule are authorised for sale in Antigua and Barbuda. Special Stamp Schedule.
3. The special Stamps authorised by this Order shall be released on sale at the General Post Office on 28th May 2001, and remain on sale until 27th August 2001 or until stocks are exhausted whichever date is sooner. Duration.
4. This Order is deemed to have come into force on 28th May 2001. Commencement.
