The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (The Caricom Awards) Order, 1994 made by the Cabinet under Sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act (Cap. 270).

1. Short title. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Caricom Awards) Order, 1994.

2. Special Stamps. Special stamps of the value of 65¢, 90¢ and \$1.20 are authorised for sale in Antigua and Barbuda.

3. Design. The design of the stamps authorised by this Order are specified in the Schedule.

4. Duration. The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale for a period of three months until 30th December, 1994 or until stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier.

5. Commencement. This Order is deemed to have come into force on the 29th September, 1994.
