The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Disney-Science Fiction) Order, 1996, made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act, Cap. 410.

1. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Disney-Science Fiction) Order, 1996. Short title.
2. Special Stamps of the value of 1¢, 2¢, 5¢, 10¢, 15¢, 20¢, \$1.00, \$2.00, \$3.00, \$5.00 and two souvenir sheets costing \$6.00 each are authorised for use in Antigua and Barbuda. Special Stamps.
3. The design of stamps authorised by this Order are specified in the Schedule. Design.
4. The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale for a period of three months until 5th September 1996 or until stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier. Duration.
5. This Order is deemed to have come into force on the 6th June, 1996. Commencement.

The stamps are multicoloured, of horizontal format and depict the following—

10¢	depicts <i>From the Earth to the Moon.</i>
15¢	depicts <i>Five weeks in a balloon.</i>
20¢	depicts <i>Around the World in 80 days.</i>
\$1.00	depicts <i>The Mysterious Island.</i>
\$2.00	depicts <i>From Earth to Moon.</i>

\$3.00	depicts <i>Captain Grants' Children.</i>
\$5.00	depicts <i>20,000 Leagues under the Sea.</i>
\$6.00	Souvenir Sheet I — depicts <i>Journey to the Centre of the Earth.</i>
\$6.00	Souvenir Sheet II — depicts <i>20,000 Leagues under the Sea.</i>
