The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) Great Ships Order, 1996 made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act (Cap. 410).

- 1. Short title. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) Great Ships Order, 1996.
- 2. Special Stamps. Special Stamps of the value of 15¢, 25¢, 45¢, 75¢, 90¢, two invenir sheets of the value of \$6.00 each and two sheetlets containing six stamps \$17.20 and \$9.00 respectively are authorised for sale in Antigua and Barbuda.
- 3. Design. The designs of the stamps authorised by this Order are specified in the stamps.
- 4. Duration. The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale 26th July, 1996.
- 5. Commencement. This Order comes into force on 25th April, 1996.
