The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) Great Ships Order, 1996 made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act (Cap. 410).

1. **Short title.** This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) Great Ships Order, 1996.

2. **Special Stamps.** Special Stamps of the value of 15¢, 25¢, 45¢, 75¢, 90¢, two souvenir sheets of the value of \$6.00 each and two sheetlets containing six stamps of \$7.20 and \$9.00 respectively are authorised for sale in Antigua and Barbuda.

3. **Design.** The designs of the stamps authorised by this Order are specified in the Schedule.

4. **Duration.** The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale until 26th July, 1996.

5. **Commencement.** This Order comes into force on 25th April, 1996.

The stamps are multicoloured, of horizontal format and depict the following —

75¢ (2)	depicts <i>Sovereign of the Seas</i> (England 1637)
90¢	depicts <i>H.M.S. Victory</i> (England 1765)
Souvenir Sheet I	depicts <i>USS Constitution 1797</i>
Souvenir Sheet II	depicts <i>Cartier's Grande Hermine</i>
Sheetlet I	depicts <i>Columbus' Santa Maria, Magellan's Victoria, Drake's Golden Hind, Pilgrim Fathers' Mayflower, La Salle's Griffin and Cook's Resolution.</i>

Sheetlet II depicts *Aemilia* (Holland 1630), *Sovereign of the Seas* (England 1637), *Royal Louis* (France 1666), *H.M.S. Royal George* (English 1715), *Protecteur* (France 1761), *H.M.S. Victory* (England 1765).
