**The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) Hong Kong Expo '94 made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act (Cap. 270).**

**1. Short title.** This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) Hong Kong Expo '94 Order, 1994.

**2. Special Stamps.** Special stamps in two sheetlets. The first sheetlet of ten 40¢ stamps and the second sheetlet of six 40¢ are authorised for sale in Antigua and Barbuda.

**3. Design.** The design of the stamps authorised by this Order are multicoloured and of horizontal format and depict the following —

- (a) Five of the sheetlet of ten stamps depict Antigua and Barbuda stamp featuring a Rock Beauty (*Holacanthus Tricolour*) fish, and five others depict a Hong Kong stamp featuring a (*Nemipterus Ougatus*) fish. The Hong Kong Expo '94 logo which features the Central Plaza, the Highest Building in Asia is imprinted on each stamp and on selvedge of sheetlet.
- (b) The sheetlet of six 40¢ stamps depict the following —
  - (a) Inside the Museum.
  - (b) Cavalry Man and Horse.
  - (c) Warriors in Battle Formation.
  - (d) Painted Bronze Horses & Chariot.
  - (e) Pekingese Dog.
  - (f) Chinese Warrior Figures & Horses.

**4. Commencement.** This Order is deemed to have come into force on the 18th day of February, 1994 and the special stamps will remain on sale until the 17th day of May, 1994 or until stocks are exhausted, whichever is earlier.
