The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Marine Life) Order 2001, made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act, Cap. 270.

- 1. This Order is cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) Short title. (Marine Life) Order, 2001.
- 2. Special stamps of the value of 25 cents, 45 cents, 65 cents, Special stamps. 90 cents, \$1.00; four sheetlets with six stamps of the value of \$1.20 and \$1.65 each; and four souvenir sheets at \$6.00 each are authorised for sale.
- 3. The designs of the stamps authorised by this Order are Design. depicted as follows —

The 25 cents depicts the Yellow Tail Damselfish

The 45 cents depicts the Indigo Hamlet

The 65 cents depicts the Great White Shark

The 90 cents depicts the Bottle — nose Dolphin and Palette Sturgeonfish

The \$1.00 depicts the Octopus
