The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Queen Mother 101st Birthday) Order, made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act, Cap. 410.

1. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Queen Mother 101st Birthday) Order, 2002. Short title.
2. A special stamp of the value of \$2.00 each in a sheetlet comprising four stamps and one (1) souvenir sheet at \$6.00 are authorised for sale. Special stamps.
3. The designs of the stamps authorised by this Order are specified in the Schedule. Design.
4. The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale for three months until 16th March 2002 or earlier if stock becomes exhausted before that date. Duration.
5. This Order is deemed to have come into force on 17th December 2001. Commencement.
