The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Disney — Mickey's 65th Anniversary) Order, 1993, made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act (Cap. 270).

1. Short Title. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Disney — Mickey's 65th Anniversary) Order, 1993.

2. Special Stamps. Special Stamps of the value of 10c., 15c., 30c., 40c., 50c., \$1.00, \$2.00, \$4.00, \$5.00 and two (2) Souvenir Sheets of the value of \$6.00 each are authorised for use in Antigua and Barbuda.

3. Design. The designs of the stamps authorised by this Order are specified in the Schedule.

4. Duration. The Special Stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale until 24th January, 1994 or until stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier.

5. Commencement. This Order comes into force on the 25th October, 1993.
