**The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Queen Mother and Queen Mother Gold) Order made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act, Cap. 410.**

1. This Order may be cited as the Stamps (Antigua and Barbuda) (Queen Mother and Queen Mother Gold) Order, 2000. Short title.
  2. Special stamps of the value and description specified in the Schedule are authorised for sale in Antigua and Barbuda. Special Stamp Schedule.
  3. The Special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale for a period of three (3) months until 3rd November, 2000, or until stocks are exhausted, whichever date is sooner. Duration.
  4. This Order is deemed to have come into force on 4th August, 2000. Commencement.
