**The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Mickey's Hong Kong '94) Order, 1994
made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act (Cap. 270).**

1. Short title. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Mickey's Hong Kong '94) Order, 1994.

2. Special Stamps. Special stamps of the value of 10¢, 15¢, 30¢, 50¢, \$1.00, \$2.00, \$4.00, \$5.00 and two (2) Souvenir Sheets of the value of \$6.00 each are authorised for use in Antigua and Barbuda.

3. Design. The design of the stamps authorised by this Order are specified in the Schedule.

4. Duration. The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale until 17th May, 1994 or until stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier.

5. Commencement. This Order is deemed to have come into force on the 18th February, 1994.

The Stamps are multicoloured, of vertical format and depict the following —

15¢	depicts Mandarin Minnie.
30¢	depicts Donald and Daisy Journey by Houseboat.
50¢	depicts Mickey the Birdman of Monk Kok.
\$1.00	depicts Pluto Encounters a Good Luck Dog.
\$2.00	depicts Minnie and Daisy Celebrate the Bun Festival.
\$4.00	depicts Goofy, the Noodle Maker.
\$5.00	depicts Goofy Pulls Mickey in a Rickshaw.

\$6.00 Souvenir Sheet I depicts Mickey and Pals Celebrate the New Year
in the traditional dragon dance.

\$6.00 Souvenir Sheet II depicts A Grand View of Hong Kong Harbour.
