STATUTORY INSTRUMENTS

The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Hummel) Order, 1993 made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act (Cap. 270).

1. Short title. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Hummel) Order, 1993.

2. Special stamp. Special Stamps of the Value of 15c., 30c., 40c., \$1.00, \$2.00, \$4.00, \$5.00 and two sheetlets comprising four stamps at \$1.50 each are authorised for use in Antigua and Barbuda.

3. Design. The designs of the stamps authorised by this Order are multi-coloured, of vertical format and depict figurines by Maria I. Hummel under the theme "The World Most Beloved Children"

4. Duration. The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain in force until the 17th day of April, 1993 or until stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier.

5. Commencement. This Order is deemed to have come into force on the 18th January, 1993.
