## STATUTORY INSTRUMENTS

## 1993, No. 17

The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Euro-Disney) Order, 1993 made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act (Cap. 270).

- 1. Short title. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Euro-Disney) Order, 1993.
- **2. Special Stamps.** Special Stamps of the Value of 10c., 25c., 30c., 40c., \$1.00, \$2.00, \$4.00, \$5.00 and four Souvenir Sheets of the value of \$6.00 each are authorised for use in Antigua and Barbuda.
- 3. Designs. The designs of the stamps authorised by this Order are specified in the Schedule.
- **4. Duration.** The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale until 21st May, 1993 or until stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier.
- **5.** Commencement. This Order shall come into force on the 22nd February, 1993.

## **SCHEDULE**

The Stamps are multi-coloured, of vertical format and depict the following —

Value	Description
10c.	features Goofy on Golf Course "Le Golf D' Euro-Disney" against a background of a fantasy castle, reminiscent of European fairy tales.
25c.	features Chip and Dale on "Davy Crockett Camp Ground".
30c.	features Donald Duck as a cowboy from America's "Old West" outside "the Cheyenne Hotel".
40c.	features Goofy in Mexican attire outside "the Santa Fe Hotel".
\$1.00	features Mickey and Minnie outside "the New York Hotel".
\$2.00	features Mickey, Minnie and Goofy on a map of Paris.
\$4.00	features Goofy in attire as one of "the Pirates of the Caribbean".

Value	Description
\$5.00	features Donald Duck as Aladdin in "Adventureland" outside "Le Choppe d'Aladdin".
\$6.00	Souvenir Sheet No. 1 features Mickey on a map of Paris.
\$6.00	Souvenir Sheet No. 2 features Mickey and newspaper "Mickey Reporter ouverture 12 Avril 1992".
\$6.00	Souvenir Sheet No. 3 features Mickey holding a poster inscribed "Ouverture 12 Avril 1992".
\$6.00	Souvenir Sheet No. 4 features "The Disneyland Hotel".
