- (Butterflies) Order, 1994. 1. Short title. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda)
- for use in Antigua and Barbuda. 2. Special Stamp. Special stamps of the value of 10c, 15c, 30c, 40c, \$1.00, \$2.00, \$4.00, \$5.00 and two (2) souvenir sheets of the value of \$6.00 each are authorised
- in the Schedule. 3. The design. The design of the stamps authorised by this Order are specified
- **4.Duration.** The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale until 26 September, 1994 or until stocks are exhausted which ever is earlier.
- 5. Commencement. This Order is deemed to have come into force on the 27th
