

## ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA

### STATUTORY INSTRUMENTS

1994, No. 29

The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Butterflies) Order, 1994 made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act (Cap. 270).

1. **Short title.** This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Butterflies) Order, 1994.
2. **Special Stamp.** Special stamps of the value of 10c, 15c, 30c, 40c, \$1.00, \$2.00, \$4.00, \$5.00 and two (2) souvenir sheets of the value of \$6.00 each are authorised for use in Antigua and Barbuda.
3. **The design.** The design of the stamps authorised by this Order are specified in the Schedule.
4. **Duration.** The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale until 26 September, 1994 or until stocks are exhausted which ever is earlier.
5. **Commencement .** This Order is deemed to have come into force on the 27th June, 1994.

The stamps are multicoloured, of vertical format and feature the following —

10¢	features the Monarch ( <i>Danaus plexippus</i> )
15¢	features the Florida White ( <i>Appisa drusilla</i> )
30¢	features the Little Sulphur ( <i>Eurema lisa</i> )
40¢	features the Troglodyte ( <i>Anaea troglodyta</i> )
\$1.00	features the Common Long-Tail Skipper ( <i>Urbanus proteus</i> )
\$2.00	features the Caribbean Buckeye ( <i>Junonia evarete</i> )
\$4.00	features the Polydamas Swallowtail ( <i>Battus polydamas</i> )
\$5.00	features the Zebra ( <i>Heliconius charitonius</i> )

\$6.00 Souvenir Sheet I features the Hanno Blue (*Hemiaragus hanno*)  
\$6.00 Souvenir Sheet II features the Cloudless Sulphur (*Phoebis  
senae*)
