The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Transport) Order, 1995 made by the Cabinet under Sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act (Cap. 270).

- 1. Short title. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Transport) Order, 1995.
- 2. Special Stamp. Special Stamps of the value of 35ϕ , 65ϕ , 75ϕ , 90ϕ , \$1.20, \$6.00; two Souvenir Sheets of the value of \$6.00 each; and one Sheetlet containing nine stamps at the value of \$1.20 each are authorised for sale in Antigua and Barbuda.
- 3. Design. The designs of the stamps authorised by this Order are specified in the Schedule.
- **4. Duration.** The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale for three months until 24th November, 1995 or until stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier.
 - 5. Commencement. This Order comes into force on the 23rd October, 1995.
