

# ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA

## STATUTORY INSTRUMENTS

1995, No. 43

**The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Transport) Order, 1995 made by the Cabinet under Sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act (Cap. 270).**

**1. Short title.** This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Transport) Order, 1995.

**2. Special Stamp.** Special Stamps of the value of 35¢, 65¢, 75¢, 90¢, \$1.20, \$6.00; two Souvenir Sheets of the value of \$6.00 each; and one Sheetlet containing nine stamps at the value of \$1.20 each are authorised for sale in Antigua and Barbuda.

**3. Design.** The designs of the stamps authorised by this Order are specified in the Schedule.

**4. Duration.** The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale for three months until 24th November, 1995 or until stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier.

**5. Commencement.** This Order comes into force on the 23rd October, 1995.

\$1.20 —	features French High Speed Train
\$6.00 —	features American High Speed Train

\$6.00 —	Souvenir Sheet I features the Australian <i>Indian Pacific</i> making the journey from Sydney to Perth.
\$6.00 —	Souvenir Sheet II features an <i>Iron Rooster</i> crossing the Yangtze River in China.

**\$1.20 — One sheetlet feature nine stamps of the World, namely:**

**Australian Diesel, Italian High Speed Train, Thai Diesel, United States Steam, South African Steam, Natal Steam, United States War Train, British Steam, British Steam.**
