The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Birds) Order, 1996, made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act, Cap. 410.

1. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Birds) Order, 1996. Short title.
2. Eight special stamps of the value of 75¢ and two souvenir sheets of the value of \$5.00 and \$6.00 are authorised for use in Antigua and Barbuda. Special Stamps.
3. The design of stamps are specified in the Schedule. Design.
4. The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale until the 14th of August, 1996 or until stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier. Duration.
5. This Order comes into force on 13th May, 1996. Commencement.
