The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Cavalry) Order 1996, made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act, Cap. 410.

1. Short title. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Cavalry) Order, 1996.

2. Special Stamps. Special Stamps are in Sheetlets comprising sixteen stamps each in the denomination of 60¢ and a Souvenir Sheet costing \$6.00.

3. Design. The designs of the stamps authorised by this Order are specified in the Schedule.

4. Duration. The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale for a period of three (3) months until 23rd October, 1996 or until stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier.

5. Commencement. This Order comes into force on the 24th day of July, 1996.
