**The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Cavalry) Order 1996, made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act, Cap. 410.**

**1. Short title.** This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Cavalry) Order, 1996.

**2. Special Stamps.** Special Stamps are in Sheetlets comprising sixteen stamps each in the denomination of 60¢ and a Souvenir Sheet costing \$6.00.

**3. Design.** The designs of the stamps authorised by this Order are specified in the Schedule.

**4. Duration.** The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale for a period of three (3) months until 23rd October, 1996 or until stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier.

**5. Commencement.** This Order comes into force on the 24th day of July, 1996.

The stamps are multicoloured, of horizontal format and depict the following —
