**The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Olympics) Order, 1996,
made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act,
Cap. 410.**

1. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Olympics) Order, 1996. Short title.
2. Special stamps of the value of 65¢, 75¢, 90¢, \$1.20, two (2) sheetlets containing nine (9) stamps each of the value of \$8.10 per sheetlet and two (2) souvenir sheets of the value of \$5.00 and \$6.00 respectively. Special Stamps.
3. The designs of the stamps authorised by this Order are specified in the Schedule. Design.
4. The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale until the 7th of August, 1996 or until stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier. Duration.
5. This Order comes into force on the 6th day of May, 1996. Commencement.
