The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Olympics) Order, 1996, made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act, Cap. 410.

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) Short title. (Olympics) Order, 1996.
- 2. Special stamps of the value of 65%, 75%, 90%, \$1.20, two (2) Special Stamps. sheetlets containing nine (9) stamps each of the value of \$8.10 per sheetlet and two (2) souvenir sheets of the value of \$5.00 and \$6.00 respectively.
- 3. The designs of the stamps authorised by this Order are Design. specified in the Schedule.
- 4. The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale until the 7th of August, 1996 or until stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier.
 - 5. This Order comes into force on the 6th day of May, 1996. Commencement.
