The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Orchids) Order made by the Cabinet under Sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act Cap. 410.

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) Short title. (Orchids) Order, 1997.
- 2. Special Stamps of the value of 45¢, 65¢, 75¢, 90¢, \$1.00, \$2.00 and two (2) Souvenir sheets at the value of \$6.00 each, and Sheetlet containing eight (8) stamps at the cost of \$1.65 each are authorised for sale in Antigua and Barbuda.

- 3. The design of the stamps authorised by this Order are specified in the Schedule.
- 4. The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale for a period of three (3) months until the 20th October, 1997 or until all stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier.
- 5. This Order is deemed to have come into force on the 19th Commencement. August, 1997.
