The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Entertainers) Order 2002, made by the Cabinet under Sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act, Cap. 410.

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Short title. Barbuda) (Entertainers) Order 2002.
- 2. Special Stamps of the value of \$1.00, \$1.50 and \$1.80 each Special Stamp. on four (4) Sheetlets, and one (1) Souvenir Sheet of the value of \$6.00 are authorized for sale in Antigua and Barbuda.
- 3. The design of the stamps authorized by this Order are speci-Design. fied in the Schedule.
- 4. The special stamps authorized by this Order shall remain on sale for a period of three (3) months until 15th December, 2002 or until stocks are exhausted, whichever is earlier.
- 5. This Order is deemed to have come into force on the 16th Commencement. September, 2002.
