**The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Entertainers) Order
2002, made by the Cabinet under Sections 4 and 5 of the
Stamp Act, Cap. 410.**

1. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Entertainers) Order 2002. Short title.
2. Special Stamps of the value of \$1.00, \$1.50 and \$1.80 each on four (4) Sheetlets, and one (1) Souvenir Sheet of the value of \$6.00 are authorized for sale in Antigua and Barbuda. Special Stamp.
3. The design of the stamps authorized by this Order are specified in the Schedule. Design.
4. The special stamps authorized by this Order shall remain on sale for a period of three (3) months until 15th December, 2002 or until stocks are exhausted, whichever is earlier. Duration.
5. This Order is deemed to have come into force on the 16th September, 2002. Commencement.
