## STATUTORY INSTRUMENTS

## 1995, No. 25

The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Slices of Caribbean Life — Tourism) Order, 1995 made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act (Cap. 270).

- 1. Short title. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Slices of Caribbean Life Tourism) Order, 1995.
- 2. Special stamp. A special stamp of the value of \$2.00 is authorised for use in Antigua and Barbuda.
  - 3. Design. The design of the stamp is specified in the Schedule.
- **4. Duration.** The special stamp authorised by this Order shall remain on sale until 11th November, 1995 or earlier if stocks become exhausted before that date.
  - 5. Commencement. This Order comes into force on 10th August, 1995.

The stamps are multicoloured, of vertical format and feature the following —

- (1) Caring
- (2) Marketing
- (3) Working
- (4) Enjoying life.
