The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Boats) Order made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act, Cap. 410.

1. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Boats) Order, 1999. Short title.
2. Special stamps of the value of 25¢, 45¢, 60¢, 90¢, \$1.20 and one (1) sheetlet comprising of five (5) stamps in the same denominations and description are featured as Antigua and Barbuda Boats and Ships, sailing in and around Antigua and Barbuda. Special stamps.
3. The design of the stamps authorised by this Order are specified in the Schedule. Design.
4. The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale for three (3) months until 23rd September, 1999 or earlier if stock becomes exhausted before that date. Duration.
5. This Order is deemed to have come into force on 24th June, 1999. Commencement.

The stamps are multicoloured, of vertical format and depict the following —

.90¢	depicts	—	10th Anniversary of the <i>Freewind's</i> visit to Antigua
\$1.20	depicts	—	The <i>Monarch of the Seas</i> .

One Sheetlet comprising five (5) stamps in the same denominations and descriptions as above.
