| 1. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Bicentennial of the Louvre) Order, 1993.   | Short title.    |
| 2. A Special stamp of the value of \$1.00 each in a sheetlet of eight stamps and a souvenir sheet of the value of \$6.00 are authorised for use in Antigua and Barbuda. | Special Stamps. |
| 3. The design of this stamp authorised by this Order are specified in the Schedule.   | Design.         |
| 4. The special stamp authorised by this Order shall remain in force until the 21st June, 1993 or until stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier.                       | Duration.       |
| 5. This Order is deemed to have come into force on the 22nd day of March, 1993.   | Commencement.   |
