STATUTORY INSTRUMENTS

The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) Dogs of the World Order, 1994 made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act (Cap. 270).

1. Short title. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) Dogs of the World Order, 1994.

2. Special Stamps. Special stamps in two (2) sheetlets; Sheetlet I comprises of twelve (12) stamps in the denomination of 50¢; Sheetlet II comprises of twelve (12) stamps in the denomination of 75¢ and two (2) Souvenir Sheets costing \$6.00 each are authorised for sale in Antigua and Barbuda.

3. Design. The design of the stamps authorised by this Order are multicoloured and of horizontal format.

- (a) Sheetlet I — "Small Breeds" features the following Dogs — West Highland White Terrier, Beagle, Scottish Terrier, Pekingese, Dachshund, Yorkshire Terrier, Pomeranian, Poodle, Shetland Sheepdog, Pug, Shih Tzu and Chihuahua;
- (b) Sheetlet II — "Large Breeds" features the following Dogs — Mastif, Border Collie, Samoyed, Airedale Terrier, English Setter, Rough Collie, Newfoundland, Weimarana, English Springer Spaniel, Dalmatian, Boxer and Old English Sheepdog;
- (c) Souvenir Sheet I features a Labrador Retriever;
- (d) Souvenir Sheet II features a Welsh Corgi.

4. Duration. The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale until 4th July, 1994 or until stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier.

5. Commencement. This Order is deemed to have come into force on the 5th day of April, 1994.
