- 2. Special stamps of the value and description specified in the Special stamps Schedule are authorised for sale in Antigua and Barbuda. Schedule.
- 3. The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale until 18th July, 1999 or until stocks are exhausted whichever date is sooner.
