- The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Pre-Olympics) Order, 1995 made by the Cabinet under Sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act (Cap. 270).
- Short title. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Pre-Olympics) Order, 1995.
- 2. Special Stamps. special stamps of the value of 15¢, 20¢, 65¢, 90¢, \$1.20, \$5.00 and two Souvenir sheets at \$6.00 each are authorized for sale in Antigua and Barbuda.
- 3. Design. The design of the stamps authorized by this Order are specified in the Schedule.
- 4. Duration. The special stamps authorized by this Order shall remain on sale for a period of three months until the 31st day of August, 1995 or until stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier.
- Commencement. This Order is deemed to have come into force on the 6th day of June, 1995.
