| <p>1. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Nobel Prizes) Order, 2002.</p>  | Short Title.   |

Special stamps of the value of \$1.50 each on two sheetlets depicting winners of Nobel Prizes in Chemistry from 1913—2000, three Souvenir Sheets of the value of \$6.00 each, two of which depict winners of Nobel Prizes in Chemistry in 1908 and 1973 and the third sheet depicts winner of the Nobel Peace Prize are authorised for sale in Antigua and Barbuda.</p> | Special Stamp. |
| <p>3. The design of the stamps authorised by this Order are specified in the Schedule.</p>  | Design.        |
| <p>4. The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale until 28<sup>th</sup> February, 2002 or until stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier.</p>   | Duration.      |
