

**ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA**

**STATUTORY INSTRUMENTS**

**1995, No. 50.**

**The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Hurricane Relief 1995) Order, 1995 made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act, Cap. 410.**

**1. Short title.** This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Hurricane Relief) Order, 1995.

**2. Special Stamps.** Special Stamps depicting Scouts and Overprinted Hurricane Relief are in two (2) sheetlets containing nine (9) stamps each in the denomination of \$1.20 each; and two (2) Souvenir Sheets costing \$6.00 each.

**3. Design.** The design of the stamps authorised by this Order is specified in the Schedule.

**4. Duration.** The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale for a period of three (3) months until 15th March, 1996 or until stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier.

**5. Commencement.** This Order comes into force on the 14th day of December, 1995.

**SCHEDULE**

The Stamps are multicoloured, of horizontal format and feature the following—

<b>Value</b>	<b>Description</b>
\$1.20	2 Sheetlets containing nine (9) stamps each and depicts three (3) different types of permanent camp tents namely the Camper, the Explorer and the Wall Tent.
\$6.00	Souvenir Sheet (I) — depicts a scout with knapsack.
\$6.00	Souvenir Sheet (II) — depicts a scout lighting a camp fire.
