## 1993, No. 25

The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Endangered Species) Order, 1993 made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the stamp Act (Cap. 270).

1. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Endangered Species) Order, 1993.

Short title.

2. A special stamp of the value of \$1.00 each in a sheetlet of twelve stamps and two souvenir sheets of the value of \$6.00 each are authorised for use in Antigua and Barbuda.

**3.** The design of the stamps authorised by this Order are specified in the Schedule.

5. This Order is deemed to have come into force on the 4th days of April, 1993.
