The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Endangered Species) Order, made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act Cap. 410.

1. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) Short title. (Endangered Species) Order, 1997.

2. Special stamps of the value of \$1.20 per stamp of sheetlet 1 containing six (6) stamps, \$1.65 per stamp of sheetlet 2 containing six (6) stamps and three (3) souvenir sheets of the value of \$6.00 each are authorised for sale in Antigua and Barbuda.

Special Stamps.

3. The design of the stamps authorised by this Order are specified in the Schedule.

4. The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale for a period of three (3) months until 25th July, 1997 or until all stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier.

5. This Order comes into force on the 24th April, 1997.
