The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Antigua and Barbuda Transportation) Order, 1993, made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act (Cap. 270).

- 1. Short title. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Antigua and Barbuda Transportation) Order, 1993.
- 2. Special Stamps. Special Stamps of the value of 30c., 40c., \$4.00, \$5.00; and five (5) Souvenir Sheets of the value of \$6.00 each are authorised for use in Antigua and Barbuda.
- 3. Design. The designs of the stamps authorised by this Order are specified in the Schedule.
- 4. Duration. The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain in force until the 10th of January, 1994 or until stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier.
- 5. Commencement. This Order is deemed to have come into force on the 11th of October, 1993.
