**The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Sir Vivian Richards)  
(A Knight of Dignity) Order 2002, made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act, Cap. 410.**

1. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (Sir Vivian Richards) (A Knight of Dignity) Order, 2002. Short Title.
2. Special stamps of the value of 25¢, 30¢, 50¢, 75¢, \$1.50, \$1.80 and two Souvenir Sheets of the value of \$6.00 each are authorised for sale in Antigua and Barbuda. Special Stamp.
3. The design of the stamps authorised by this Order are specified in the Schedule. Design.
4. The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain on sale until 6<sup>th</sup> June, 2002 or until stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier. Duration.
5. This Order is deemed to have come into force on the 7<sup>th</sup> of March, 2002. Commencement.

The stamps are multicoloured, of vertical format and depict the following—

.25¢	depicts	A jubilant West Indies Captain raising his bat in acknowledgement after his 20 <sup>th</sup> Test Century at the Antigua Recreation Ground (ARG), 15 <sup>th</sup> March 1986.
.30¢	depicts	Prime Minister Vere Cornwall Bird applauding as Governor-General, Sir Wilfred Jacobs presents a gift to West Indies Captain Viv Richards 1985.
.50¢	depicts	Sir Vivian Richards acknowledging spectators on his Conferment of Knighthood at the Antigua Recreation Ground (ARG), May 2000.

Value	Description	
.75¢	depicts	Sir Vivian Richards Batting.
\$1.50	depicts	Sir Vivian and Lady Miriam Richards after Conferment of Knighthood of Sir Vivian Richards at the Antigua Recreation Ground (ARG), May 2000.
\$1.80	depicts	Sir Vivian Richards at Hawksbill Hotel, January 30, 2000, as he received a gift (Self Portrait) from the Ovals Action Committee.
\$6.00	Souvenir Sheet 1	depicts Sir Vivian Richards in Maharaja attire, West Indies tour of India 1987.
\$6.00	Souvenir Sheet 2	depicts Sir Vivian Richads on his way to be Conferred with Knighthood, Ceremony held at the Antigua Recreation Ground (ARG), May 2000.
