STATUTORY INSTRUMENTS

1994, No. 45

The Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (World Wildlife Fund) Order, 1994, made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act (Cap. 270).

1. Short title. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Antigua and Barbuda) (World Wildlife Fund) Order, 1994.

2. Special stamp. Special Stamps of the value of 10¢, 15¢, 30¢, 40¢, two (2) \$1.00, \$3.00, \$4.00 and two (2) Souvenir Sheets of the value of \$6.00 each are authorized for use in Antigua and Barbuda.

3. Design. The design of the stamps authorized by this Order are specified in the Schedule.

4. Duration. The special stamp authorized by this Order shall remain on sale until 13th March, 1995 or until stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier.

5. Commencement. This Order comes into force on the 12th December, 1994.

\$6.00	Souvenir sheet II features — The Magnificent Frigate bird.
