STATUTORY INSTRUMENTS

1993, No. 51

The Stamp (Barbuda) ("World Bird Watch 9th, 10th October, 1993") Order, 1993, made by the Cabinet under sections 4 and 5 of the Stamp Act (Cap. 270).

1. Short title. This Order may be cited as the Stamp (Barbuda) ("World Bird Watch 9th, 10th October, 1993") Order, 1993.

2. Special Stamps. Special Stamps of the value of 60c., \$2.00, \$4.00 and \$7.00 are authorised for use in Antigua and Barbuda.

3. Design. The designs of the stamps authorised by this Order are specified in the Schedule.

4. Durations. The special stamps authorised by this Order shall remain in force until the 8th of January, 1994 or until stocks are exhausted whichever is earlier.

5. Commencement. This Order comes into force on the 9th October, 1993.

SCHEDULE

The Stamps are in four colour process and of vertical format and depict the following —

<i>Value</i>	<i>Description</i>
60c.	depicts the Troupial— <i>Iceterus iceterus</i> .
\$2.00	depicts Christmas Bird— <i>Dendroica adelaidae</i> .
\$4.00	depicts Rose Breasted Grosbeak— <i>Pheucticus ludovicianus</i> .
\$7.00	depicts Stolid Flycatcher— <i>Myiarchus stolidus</i> .
