The Chief Justice by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred on him under section 4(5) of the Supreme Court Order Cap 422A, Revised Laws of Antigua & Barbuda, 1992, as amended, and with the concurrence of the Prime Ministers and the Premiers of all the States hereby orders as follows:

1. Short title

This Order may be cited as The Supreme Court (Amendment) Order 2008, and shall be read as one with the Supreme Court Order 1976 as amended (hereinafter referred to as the “principal Order”).

2. Commencement

This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of July, 2007.

3. Amendment to section 4 of the principal Order

Section 4 of the principal Order is hereby further amended as follows:

by substituting the word ‘four’ for the word “three” appearing in subsection (3) thereof.

4. Amendment to section 4 of the principal Order

Section 4 of the principal Order is hereby further amended as follows:

By substituting the words “not more than nineteen” for the word “nine” appearing in subsection (4) thereof.
