The Chief Justice by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred on him under section 12(1) of the Supreme Court Order Cap 422A, Revised Laws of Antigua & Barbuda, 1992, as amended, and with the concurrence of the Prime Ministers and the Premiers of all States hereby orders as follows:

1. Short title

This Order may be cited as the Supreme Court (Masters) (Amendment) Order 2012.

2. Commencement

This order shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of July, 2010.

3. Amendment of section 5

The Supreme Court (Masters) Order, 2008 is amended in section 5 by deleting the word “two” and substituting the word “three”.
