THE SUPREME COURT (MASTERS)(AMENDMENT) ORDER, 2014

The Chief Justice by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred under section 12(1) of the Supreme Court Order Cap. 422A, Revised Laws of Antigua & Barbuda 1992, as amended, and with the concurrence of the Prime Ministers, Premiers and Chief Minister of all the States and Territories hereby orders as follows

1. Short title

This Order may be cited as the Supreme Court (Masters) (Amendment) Order, 2014.

2. Commencement

This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of June, 2014

3. Interpretation

In this Order “the principal Order” means The Supreme Court (Masters) Order, 2008, S. I. No. 55 of 2008.

4. Amendment of section 5

The Supreme Court (Masters) Order, 2008 is amended in section 5 by revoking the word “three” and substituting the word “five”.

5. Amendment of section 6

The principal Order is amended by revoking section 6 and substituting the following:—

“6. Variation of Number of masters

The number of Masters may be varied by Order of the Chief Justice made with the concurrence of the Prime Ministers, Premiers and Chief Minister of all of the States and Territories.”.
